


Fig.17.-A ceiling in the shrine of the Shôgun Tokugawa Iyemitsu. 図17-将軍徳川家光の神社の天 井




Fig.21.-Ground-plan of theatre at Tokio. 図21-東京の劇場の平面図




Fig.22.–Section of box or pit of theatre.




Fig.23.-Plan of gallery of theatre at Yedo. 図23-江戸の劇場の桟敷




Fig.24.-Elevation of bamboo screen (AA, Fig.23). 図24-竹製の仕切の正面図(図23 の AA)




Fig.27.–Petal of a lotus (nelumbium) flower, preserved in the Imperial treasury. 図27-天皇の宝庫に保存されて いる連の花の花弁


Fig.29.–Rough sketch of a glass ewer, preserved in the Mikado's treasury at Nara.




Fig.34.–Brazen vessel with wooden handle.




Fig.43.-Carved panel in east gateway of the temple, nishi-Hongwan-Ji, Kioto. 図43-西本願寺東門にある彫刻 された板、京都




Fig.55.-Second fence at the great Shinto shrine. 図55-大神宮の第2の塀




Fig.56.-Third fence at the great Shinto shrine. 図56-大神宮の第3の塀




Fig.57.-Fourth or inner fence at the great Shinto shrine. 図57-大神宮の第4の内塀






Fig.64.-Basket formed of the fronds of a fern.


Fig.72.-Compound bracket. 図72-複雑な腕木[組物]




Fig.83.-Plan of part of the open roof in the gatehouse of the temple Tofuku-Zi.




Fig.84.-Part of a window. 図84-窓の一部




Fig.91.-Roof. 図91-屋根




Fig.92.-Portion of roof. 図92-屋根の一部




Fig.103.-Patterns of Japanese fabrics. 図103-日本の織物の柄




Fig.104.-Diagram of ornament in gable. 図104-切妻の装飾の図




Fig.107.—Details. Showing the manner in which the parts are dovetailed together. 図107-細部. 部分部分がありつぎで結合される方法を示す




Fig.108.-Gatepost and its support. 図108-門柱とそれを支える柱




Fig.109.-Top of a bracket. 図109-腕木の先端




Fig.135. 図135[波の文様]




Fig.157.–Nimbus of a Buddhist saint in one of the old temples of Nara.




Fig.168.-Lathe 図168-轆轤




Fig.169. 図169[金箔の切り方]




Fig.170. 図170[金箔の扱い方]




Fig.171. 図171[葦の粉筒]




Fig.182. Hiroshima bronze tazza, inlaid with silver. 図182-広島青銅製脚付き鉢, 銀 象嵌




Fig.193.-Fabric untied and stretched flat.






Fig.194.-Finished silk crape fabric.
