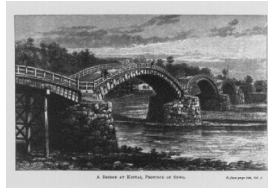

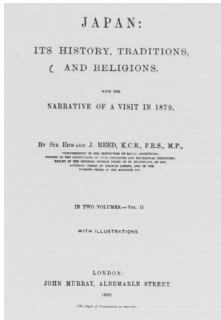


A Bridge at Kintai, province of Suwo

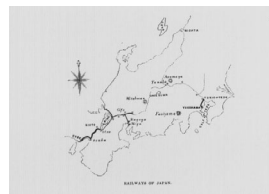

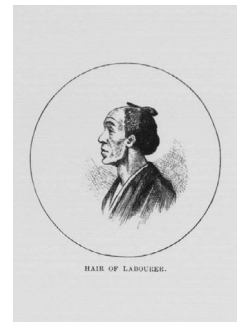

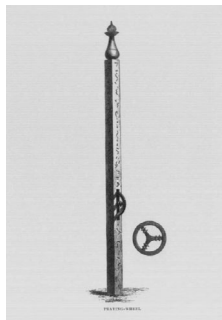

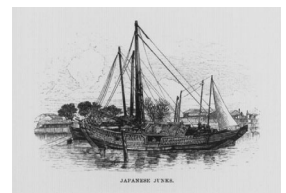

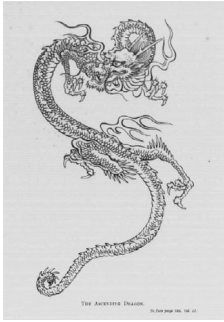

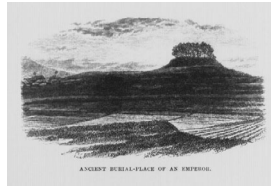

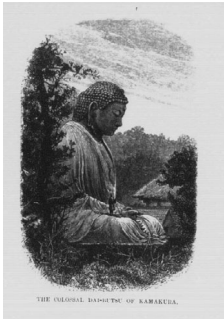

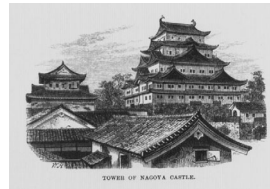

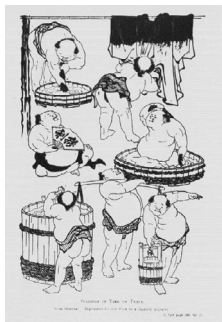

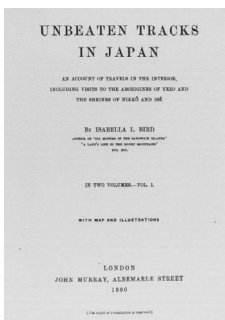
