

FINDING LIST OF POEMS TRANSLATED

The numbering at the left, below, represents the sequential *tanzaku* poem numbers assigned by the translators. The number in parentheses to the right of each entry is the *tanzaku* poem “author number” found in *Heian jinbutsushi tanzaku shūei* 平安人物志短冊集影 (Ozasa Kizō, comp., and Taira Haruki, ed., Kyoto, Shibunkaku, 1973), which contains photographic reproductions of the *tanzaku* and printed texts of the poems, both of which we have consulted in the preparation of this translation. All references to *tanzaku* poem numbers in the study and commentaries are also to this Shibunkaku number, with the publisher abbreviation “SBK.” It will be noted that in the Shibunkaku volume, *tanzaku* by the same author are grouped together under a single entry number for each author; that is, the *tanzaku* are not individually numbered, only the authors themselves. Poem 7-1, for example, is the first *tanzaku* of two under SBK 7. Titles and forewords are given below, where present in the original poems; afterwords have been omitted.
